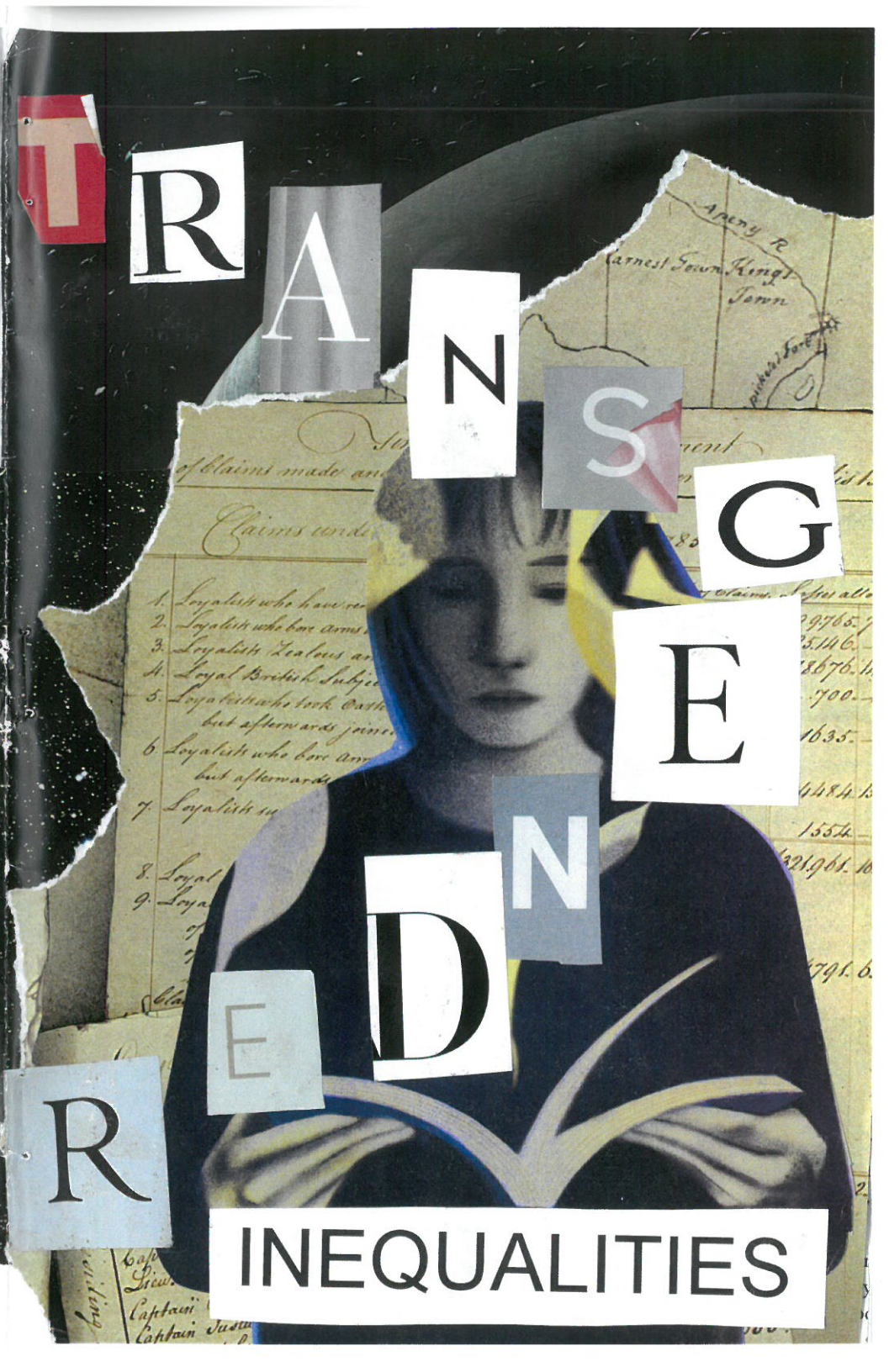

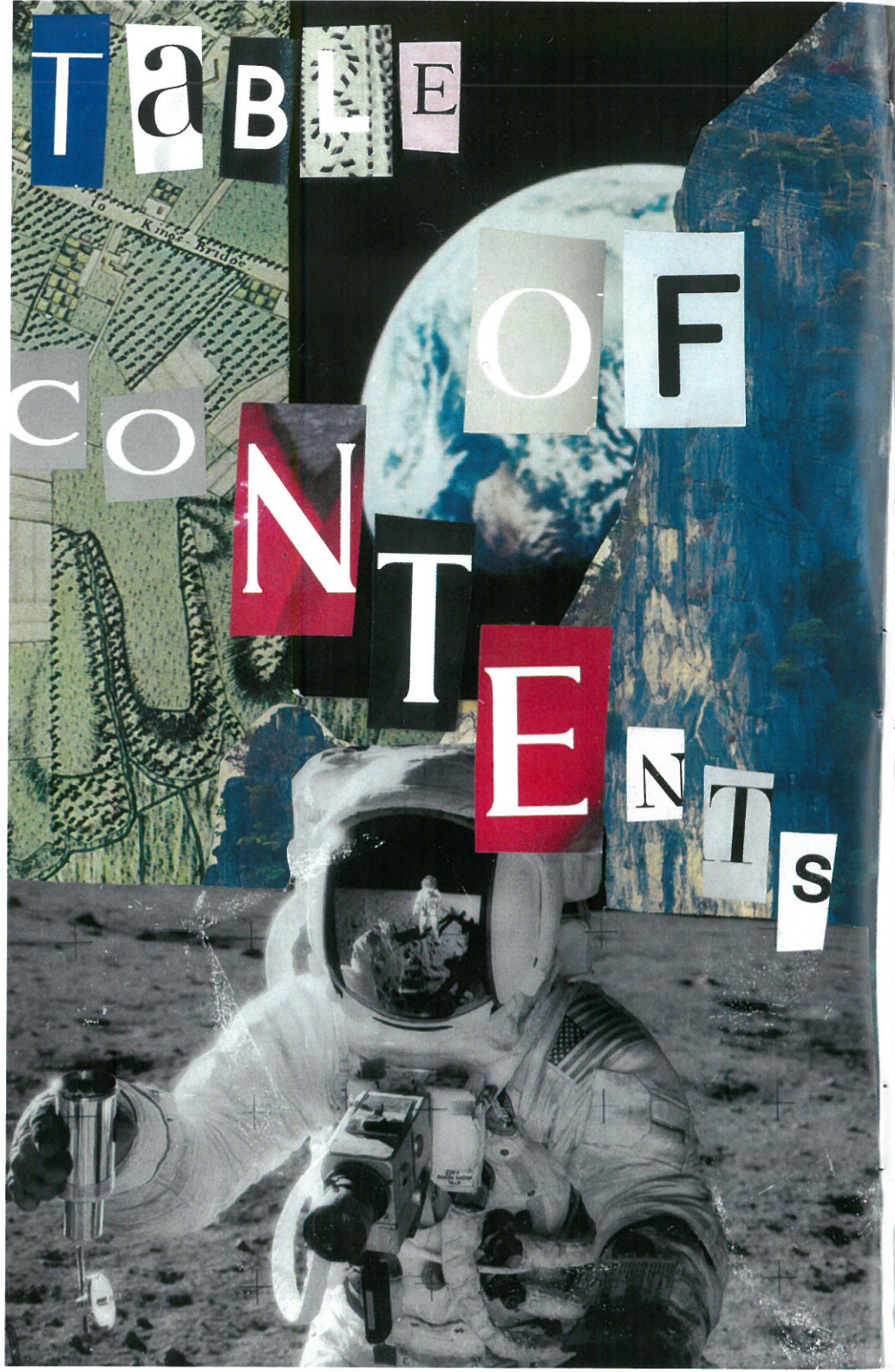

I chose SDG 10 which is Reduced Inequalities.

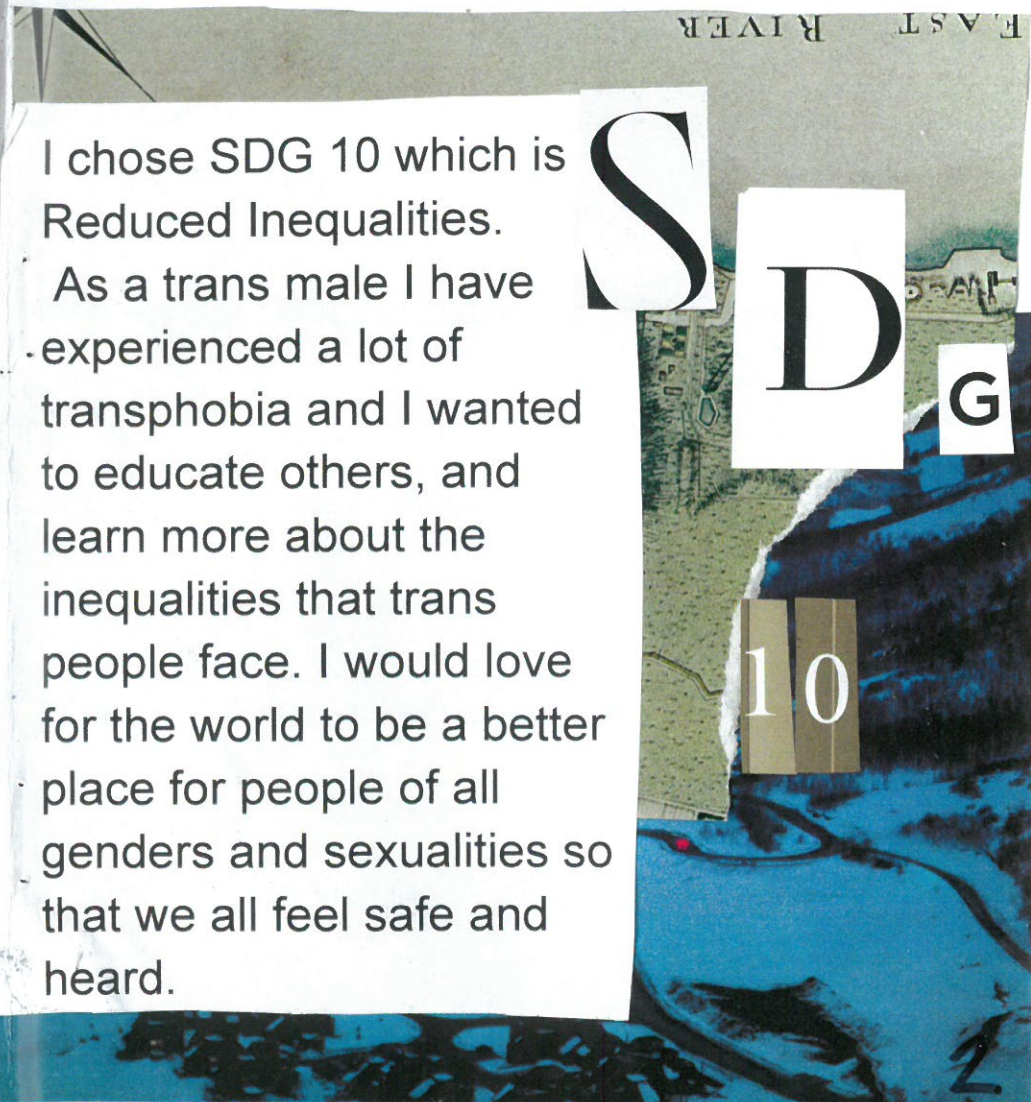

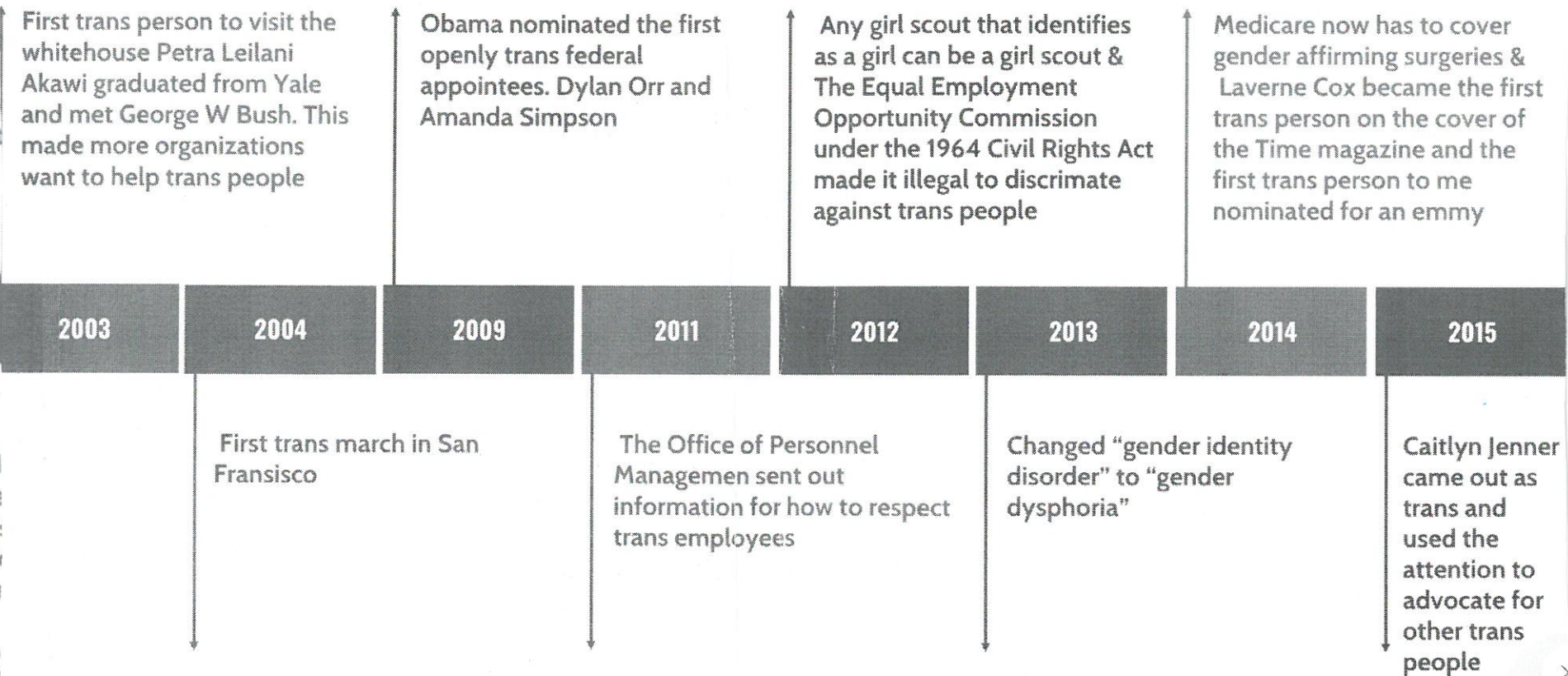



The article "Are transgender people satisfied with their lives" shows that the majority of transgender people are dissatisfied with their lives, 70% of self identifying transgender people and 64% of non-binary people are dissatisfied compared to cis people where only 34-35% of cis people are dissatisfied. The article also mentions that self satisfaction increases with age, education and better physical health.

Transgender youth are more likely to experience anxiety, depression, suicidal thoughts and are more likely to engage in self harm.

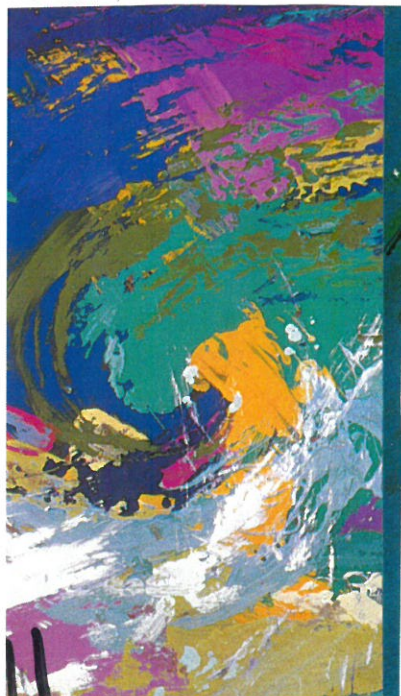
This could be because they don't have the right coping mechanisms due to their lack of education, but could also be because our society isn't a very accepting place. An interesting statistic I found was that after gender affirming surgery, life satisfaction increased on a short term scale compared to sexual gender affirming surgery that increases satisfaction on a long term scale.



To be more specific the challenges related to this sdg are helping make trans people feel more welcome in society which would probably increase satisfaction rates.



I have one personal story about a trans elder that I met once. They are two spirited and in their 60s which is older for a trans person. They talked about growing up two spirited and indigenous and how that affected them as a person. This is the first person I had met that made me feel like I could be trans and I could be okay.



1. DO Ask what pronouns to use if you are unsure! But DON'T

ask unnecessary personal questions that you wouldn't like to be asked such as

- What genitals do you have
- Have you had surgery
- How do you have sex
- What is your real name though

You wouldn't as a cis person that so don't ask trans people that either!

2. Listen to trans voices! "You don't have to understand someone's identity to respect it"

3. Be kind! You might mean well by saying

- You don't look trans
- I would date you even though you're trans
- You should wear a wig, or shave ect.. To look more like a "real man" or a "real women"

But those are actually not compliments and are all sayings based off of stereotypes! Make sure to treat trans people the way you would treat anyone else, with respect.

Instead you could say something like

- You're hair looks so good today or just simply I would date you.

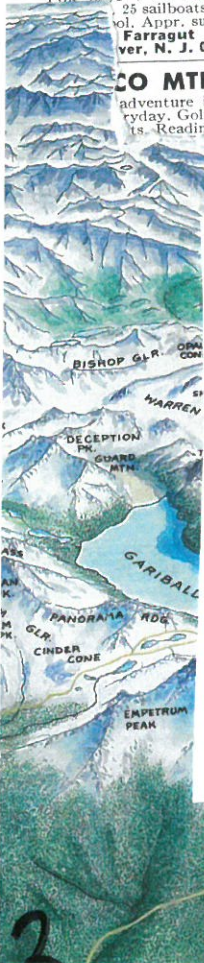
