Trust you. Because society has conditioned me to.


Love you. Because I'm afraid of what you'll do if I try to leave.

Because I want to know...


...am I enough of a woman for you yet?



#### "What were you wearing?"

A phrase that seems to weasel its way into almost every conversation centered around the topics of sexual assault and/or rape. It's also a destructive phrase, no matter how it's said. It paints the victims in a light that had they been wearing something else nothing would have happened. We know this to be false. A rapist is a rapist. It's a reported 6% of people in all of Canada that go to authorities about their sexual assault case, with a higher number of women experiencing it than men. About 50 women per 1,000 men in 2021 alone. (Statistics Canada)
