## A collaborative national approach to accelerate genomics into nursing: Lessons from the Canadian experience



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## Background

Advancements in genomics contribute to enhanced disease prevention, diagnosis and treatment.

A skilled nursing workforce can ensure patients access safe and equitable genomics - informed healthcare.

Policy and professional practice infrastructure are required to support Canada's nursing workforce in integrating genomics into nursing practice.

A coordinated and harmonized national approach is required to accelerate genomics into nursing.

## Methods

Two deliberative dialogues were held with nursing leaders representing regulatory bodies, professional associations and education.

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Grounded in implementation science frameworks:

- Consolidated Framework for Implementation Research
- Assessment of Strategic Integration of Genomics Across Nursing Maturity Matrix
- Global Genomics Nursing Alliance's Roadmap

Provided opportunities for knowledge mobilization and partnership building.

## Discussion

Four strategic directions were developed:

- 1) Raising awareness about genomics and fostering commitment to increasing genomic literacy.
- 2) Sustaining collaborative partnerships.
- Increasing advocacy efforts and investments in workforce development.
- 4) Integrating genomics into nursing education.

A toolkit was created to support genomic literacy and curriculum integration of genomics content.
